



Call for Nominations January 2018

The deadline for nominations is Friday, February 23rd.

The Capitol Hill Housing Foundation (CHH Foundation) seeks nominations of potential board members from the Seattle area. The CHH Foundation raises funds to support general operations, resident services, and capital campaigns for Capitol Hill Housing. The CHH Foundation will maintain an active list of candidates for ongoing consideration. Candidates aged 24-34, members of the LGBTQ Community and people of color are strongly encouraged to apply.

The CHH Foundation Board is comprised of around 12 members who serve two-year terms. The Board meets quarterly, with the expectation that members join a committee or workgroup (Individual Giving, Event & Sponsorship, or Executive Committee), which meet monthly.

The CHH Foundation seeks candidates who demonstrate the following interests, abilities, and characteristics:

- skills in fundraising, technology, communications, event planning, affordable housing and/or community development;
- reliability, sound judgment, flexibility and creativity;
- ability to work effectively and cooperatively with other CHH Foundation Board members, staff, community individuals, and groups with diverse backgrounds and philosophies; and
- ability to take a multi-cultural perspective and to support strategies that foster diverse, sustainable communities.

Expectations of board members include the following:

- a commitment of time and personal resources to CHH Foundation Board endeavors;
- a willingness to serve on CHH Foundation Board committees;
- a willingness to represent CHH and the CHH Foundation at community functions;
- and commitment to CHH's mission and values.
